#### INVESTING IN OUR FUTURE...



Over the summer close to half a million dollars was spent on improvements to our school. Two science labs are in the process of being completely refurbished at a

cost of \$400,000. Our field has been regraded, complete with an underground irrigation system, at a cost of \$70,000. It will

be ready for use at the start of the 2015/16 school year. Our auditorium has been refitted with new LED lighting that will reduce energy consumption by 90% as well as providing greater light for our audiences. This project cost \$10,000 and was financed in art by an energy rebate from the Welland Hydro Incentive Program.



#### COUGARS DEMONSTRATE ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE!

Congratulations to Centennial students for an outstanding set of EQAO scores in Grade 9 Math and on the Grade 10 Literacy Test. In Grade 9, 83% of our students scored at Level 3 or higher in both Academic and Applied Math, above the

Board Average. On the Literacy Test, students scored 86% (above the Board & Provincial averages) with 97% of our students taking part. This is above the 93% Provincial participation rate. Thanks to all our staff and parents for your support.
