COVID-19 School Closure:

COVID-19 School Survey

School in the Fall:

- We are currently planning for September, and how we will keep students safe and healthy
- Our plans will be based on requirements from the Ministry of Education and Public Health
- On Friday, the Ministry of Education announced that there are 3 possible models for the fall: full-time online learning, full return to school with extra health and safety precautions or a blended model that will involve some online learning and some time at school. As a result, we will not be distributing timetables until the end of the summer.
- There will be a "DSBN Return to School Updates" link added to our school website. Please be sure to check for updates regularly through the summer
