College vs. University What's the Difference?

College

- Admission is based on required Gr. 11 and 12 courses only.
- College(C), mixed (M) or university (U) courses will count in the admission average.
- Practical application
- Typically 1-3 year programs.
- Offers mostly diplomas, but some degrees (additional requirements)

University

- Admission based on 6 Gr. 12 4U/M level courses. (including required program courses).
- Gr. 12 Mixed (M) or University (U) courses will be considered for admission
- Theoretical/Research based
- Typically 4 year programs
- Offers only degrees

Adding your courses to Xello

Group 1, 2, and 3 courses can be taken in Grades 10-12. That is a lot of options!





Clicking on Add Group 1, 2, or 3 will show you all potential classes. It is best to filter by the desired grade to see the list of options for your year. You can also reference the Course Option sheet.

You can filter to higher grades to see future options, but you are encouraged to take courses at your grade level. You can take MAX 1 reach ahead credit, but priority is given to students in the higher grades.
