- Mathematics any Grade 11 (C), (U) or (M), or equivalent
- Biology Grade 11 (C) or (U) or Grade 12 (U)
- Chemistry Grade 11 (U) or Grade 12 (C) or (U) OR

Physics - Grade 11 (U) or Grade 12 (C) or (U)

Admission Requirements

Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD), or equivalent including the following required course(s):

- English Grade 12 (U), or equivalent, minimum 60%
- Mathematics any Grade 12 (U), or Grade 12 Accounting (M), or equivalent (minimum 60%)
- Four additional Grade 12 (U) or (M) level courses in any field of study
- ✓ An overall average of 65% in the six required Gr 12 (U) or (M) courses
