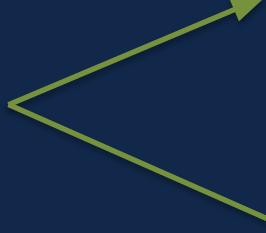

What's the Difference?

College	University
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Admission is based on required Gr. 11 and 12 courses only• College(C), mixed (M) or university (U) courses will count in the admission average• Practical application• Typically 1-3 year programs• Offers mostly diplomas, but some degrees. Degrees have university course requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Admission based on 6 Gr. 12 4U/M level courses (including required program courses)• Gr. 12 Mixed (M) or University (U) courses will be considered for admission• Theoretical/Research based• Typically 4 year programs• Offers only degrees

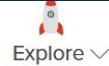

Admission based primarily on your portfolio assessment. All offers of admission are conditional on meeting the minimum academic requirements.
